I. General Statement of Purpose

This document establishes a formal Memorandum of Understanding between the SUNY Cobleskill's Bachelor of Science in Applied Psychology degree program and Utica College's Master of Science – Students with Disabilities Grade 7-12 Generalist Program.

To facilitate the admission of qualified SUNY Cobleskill Bachelor of Science in Applied Psychology degree recipients into Utica College's Master of Science – Students with Disabilities Grade 7-12 Generalist Program.

II. Requirements and Terms

- A. Students must earn a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above at the time of application to the graduate program, and maintain an overall GPA of 3.0 or above at the time of completion and graduation with the Bachelor of Science in Applied Psychology degree.
- B. Students will receive a minimum grade of C or better on all required courses for the Bachelor degree at SUNY Cobleskill, resulting in a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- C. Completion of the Bachelor of Science in Applied Psychology at SUNY Cobleskill.
- D. Students will meet the academic requirements for admission including:
 - Have a major or the equivalent in one or more of the liberal arts and sciences.
 - Have 6 credit hours or the equivalent of study in a language other than English.
 - Have 3 credit hours in the fine arts.
 - Have or complete 6 credit hours of study in each of the following courses: English, History, Math and Science.
 - Courses must show a grade of C or above.

- E. Completion of the admissions application for Utica College's Master of Science – Students with Disabilities Grade 7-12 Generalist Program.
- F. Completion of the Miller Analogies Test, as required with Utica College's graduate application.
- G. Students will provide Utica College with a final transcript listing degree posted and cumulative GPA for the Bachelor of Science in Applied Psychology degree program.

III. Benefits and Advantages

- A. Admission to Utica College's Master of Science – Students with Disabilities Grade 7-12 Generalist Program graduate degree program, leading to teacher certification, for qualified SUNY Cobleskill students.

Candidates with a base certificate in SWD 7-12 Generalist are eligible to be recommended for the extension title for “**special class teacher**” at grade level 7-12 once they have successfully completed 18 semester hours of study or its equivalent in one or more of the following:

- Earth Science
- Biology
- Chemistry
- Physics
- Social Studies
- Mathematics
- English
- Spanish
- French

For Social Studies, the candidate shall complete the 18 semester hours through a combination of study in United States history, world history and geography. (Note: History is the only area from list above that SUNY Cobleskill students will likely have 18 credits in and therefore be eligible for extension.)


- B. To attract qualified students to both institutions who wish to pursue a Master's degree leading to NYS Teacher's Certification, Students with Disabilities Grade 7-12.

IV. Review and Revision of this Memorandum of Understanding


This agreement will be reviewed in April of each academic year. Should either party desire to terminate this agreement, notification will be given to the other party, in writing, not less than six months prior to the proposed date of termination.


