They are looking to increase downtown dollars by \$100 and adding a shuttle that goes into town once a day. It was asked with the closing of Champlin, what will happen to workers. Bryan stated that they will move to Prentice. He does not want to lay anyone off, just to move them around. It was also asked if the hours be the same as before it closed down, to which Bryan said that Prentice will be open from 7am to 7pm.

Another change rolling out next year there is that there will be a new way to use your id- on your phone.
