Location

Sydney is a bustling cosmopolitan city that gives the best combination of culture, history, and scenic landscapes. Melbourne is smaller than Sydney, but no less enticing! It's one of the centers of art, fashion, education, culture, entertainment, delicious cuisine, and shopping in Australia.

Housing

Applications are accepted on a rolling basis, but candidates must apply at least 90 days before their intended internship start date.
