

# Internships in CHINA



**The Office of International Education and CISabroad have partnered to offer SUNY Cobleskill students fall, spring, or summer internships in flourishing Shanghai or Beijing, China!**

#### Location

Beijing holds a significant place in history and mixed in with tradition are the modern attractions such as the Olympic Bird's Nest, the Water Cube, and many, many skyscrapers. Shanghai has become one of the world's largest and most influential economic, technological, and international trade hubs. The city boasts a population of more than triple New York City!

#### Housing

Participants will live in self-catered shared residences with other students and interns from around the world. Housing is located across each city, generally only a short distance from each internship placement.

#### Excursions

Participants have a detailed orientation which includes help with public transportation and monthly cultural activities like cooking classes, martial arts activities, and regional excursions.

#### Internship Placements

Students can intern in subjects such as Agricultural Equipment Management, Business Administration, and Information Technology.

#### Deadline

Applications are accepted on a rolling basis, but candidates must apply at least 90 days before their intended internship start date.
