

Internships in ECUADOR



The Office of International Education and CISabroad have partnered to offer SUNY Cobleskill students fall, spring, or summer internships in historic Quito, Ecuador!

Location

Quito has something to offer every traveler. From lively festivals and dances to leafy, tranquil parks, interns are never bored of the options! Additionally, from downtown Quito participants can easily access the countless volcanoes and mountains surrounding the city.

Housing

Participants will live with local Ecuadorian families. This housing option provides participants with two meals a day. Housing is located across Quito and the surrounding areas, generally only a short distance from each internship placement.

Excursions

While interning in Ecuador participants have the chance to take one- or two-day excursions throughout their stay. The locations of the excursions vary, but the onsite director will ensure interns get the most out of their experience in Ecuador!

Internship Placements

Students can intern in a wide variety of areas such as Agricultural Business Management, Animal Science, Environmental and Energy Technologies, Early Childhood Studies, Fisheries and Aquaculture, Wildlife Management, and Plant Science.

Deadline

Applications are accepted on a rolling basis, but candidates must apply at least 90 days before their intended internship start date.
