

Internships in MEXICO



The Office of International Education and CISabroad have partnered to offer SUNY Cobleskill students fall, spring, or summer internships in picturesque Cuernavaca, Mexico!

Location

Only an hour from Mexico City, Cuernavaca provides a much more laid-back environment than the capital city. It combines a colonial past with lots of modern attractions for its lively young community. Participants enjoy walking along the safe cobblestone streets to visit authentic handcraft markets, local restaurants, bars, museums, and more!

Housing

Participants will live with local Mexican families. This housing option provides participants with two meals a day. Housing is located across Cuernavaca, only a short distance from each internship placement.

Excursions

Participants have the chance to take some daytrips to places like Mexico City, Teotihuacan, and Xochicalco to see what the rest of Mexico has to offer.

Internship Placement

Students can intern in areas such as Culinary Arts Management and Early Childhood Studies.

Deadline

Applications are accepted on a rolling basis, but candidates must apply at least 90 days before their intended internship start date.

Cost

This fee does not include international airfare, meals, and spending money but estimates are provided.
