ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN

PLATTSBURGH STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK

AND

SUNY COBLESKILL

This articulation agreement is intended to facilitate the transfer of graduates from Cobleskill State University of New York associate in applied science degree in Early Childhood to the baccalaureate degree Child Family Services: Study Option in Child Care Management (Curriculum 411) at PLATTSBURGH STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK. The objectives, terms and conditions of this agreement are set forth as follows:

OBJECTIVES

- 1. To attract qualified students to SUNY Cobleskill and Plattsburgh State.
- 2. To facilitate upward educational and career mobility in Child Family Services: Study Option in Child Care Management programs by increasing accessibility to baccalaureate education for qualified individuals.
- 3. To promote efficient transfer of qualified graduates from SUNY Cobleskill to Plattsburgh State.
- 4. To disseminate program specific information to students who wish to obtain a baccalaureate degree in Child Family Services: Study Option in Child Care Management.
- 5. To provide students with advisement in academic and career planning throughout their program of studies.
- 6. To reduce unnecessary repetition of general education and curricular content.
- 7. To facilitate communication and academic coordination between faculty, students and administrators at each institution.

TERMS OF AGREEMENT

- 1. A graduate from SUNY Cobleskill will be accepted as a matriculated student in the baccalaureate Child Family Services: Study Option in Child Care Management program at Plattsburgh State upon meeting the following conditions:
 - a. Application for admission to Plattsburgh State will be the responsibility of the SUNY Cobleskill graduate.
 - b. To be eligible for acceptance, applicants must have achieved a minimum over-all cumulative grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale for all completed college level courses.
- 2. A Bachelor of Science degree with a major in Child Family Services: Study Option in Child Care Management will be awarded the student upon meeting the following requirements:
 - a. Satisfactory completion of a minimum of 120 credits.
 - b. A minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.
 - c. A minimum cumulative G.P.A. of 2.0 is required in all departmental requirements (CDF, CEM, FNI, SOC) and in the Business minor.
 - d. A minimum grade of "C" in English Composition (ENG 101).

- Completion of a minimum of 60 credit hours in the liberal arts. e.
- Completion of Residency Requirement: (1) 36 credit hours granted by Plattsburgh State, (2) 18 credit f. hours within major field of study (CDF, CEM, FNI, CLG).
- All required Child Family Services: Study Option in Child Care Management courses have been g. satisfied
- All required General Education courses have been satisfied. h.
- All upper division course requirements have been satisfied. i.
- Admitted transfer students will be granted, under normal circumstances, junior standing (upper division status) 3. upon presentation of 57 or more transferable credits.
- Upon acceptance and initial program planning, students will be provided with a projected junior and senior year 4. schedule listing specific major and general education requirements to be completed.
- SUNY Cobleskill and Plattsburgh State will disseminate information about this articulation agreement in 5. appropriate publications and/or media.
- Changes in this articulation agreement can be made at any time by mutual consent. 6.
- This agreement will remain in effect until terminated by either party. Termination would require no less than six 7. months notification by either party.
- This articulation agreement will be revised annually by the designated person(s) at SUNY Cobleskill and 8. Plattsburgh State.
