


EOP Shining Star




Determined— That is the first word that comes to mind which most appropriately describes EOP's current Shining Star Student.








Wellness Center staff spoke to the incoming freshmen about all of the services they provide and shared tips on staying healthy in college. (shown in photo above)





On Saturday, July 26th we dressed to impress and traveled to Cooperstown to attend the performance of Carousel. What an amazing experience for all of us!

















Peer Counselors lead the students in reciting the "Promise to Myself". After the oath was taken, it was time for more celebratory hugs and goodbye tears.






NEW STUDENT ARRIVAL DAY 8/21/14

Athletics & Recreation 2014-2015



EOP family member, Alexis Nunez, was named the men's basketball team's Most Valuable Player (MVP) for the 2014-15 season, during which he also scored his 1000th career point. During this final season for the graduating senior, in 28 appearances, including 27 starts, Alexis averaged 15.8 points, 3.4 assists, 4.1 rebounds and 1.6 steals per contest while shooting 42.6% from the field, including 40.5% from three-point range, and 78.1 % from the free throw line. He will leave the program as its alltime leader in career points, career games played, career steals, career minutes played, career field goals made and career free throws made. Your EOP family is so proud of your achievements, both on the court, and in the classroom, and have enjoyed watching you excel in both!
