HONORS CAPSTONE PROJECT CONTRACT

Participants in the Honors Program complete an Honors Capstone Project (HONR 299 or HONR 499) in their final semester (next-to-last semester for Bachelor of Technology students who do an internship.)

This is an independent study, three-credit "capstone" course – it consolidates and builds upon previous coursework in the major. The student works with the supervising professor to design and carry out an independent project that involves some combination of reading, research, practicum, and writing. A summary activity is required – typically a presentation, although other formats such as paper, performance, demonstration, etc. may be more suitable in individual cases. The transcript entry reads "Honors Capstone Project." Ordinarily this course substitutes for one required course in the student's major program. (This description is not meant to preclude alternate appropriate designs.)
