

SUNY Cobleskill - Campus Scholarship Policy - Updated 09/24/2025

- All admitted students who are awarded a Cobleskill scholarship must complete a FAFSA, a
 Cobleskill scholarship questionnaire, and submit a deposit. If these are not received by SUNY
 Cobleskill by the deadlines below then any scholarships awarded for that semester will be
 forfeited.
- 2. Cobleskill offers a variety of single year and renewable scholarships. If a Cobleskill scholarship is not specifically identified as a renewable scholarship in #3 below, then it is awarded only for the student's first year of attendance.
- 3. The following Cobleskill scholarships are renewable up to 4 years (2 years for associate degrees) so long as the student maintains the indicated minimum cumulative GPAs:

- 4. All annual scholarship awards are divided evenly between the fall and spring semesters.
- 5. To serve the largest number of students, scholarships cannot overlap. If a student is eligible for more than one scholarship or other housing financial aid, they will be awarded the scholarship/aid with the highest value.
- 6. All billed charges that are not covered by a Cobleskill Scholarship must be paid in full by the billing due date (cash, financial aid, other forms of assistance or a monthly payment plan must be in place).
- 7. SUNY Cobleskill reserves the right to remove a campus scholarship from any student's account if an unpaid balance of \$100 or more remains on the account 30 days after the end of the semester.
- 8. A Cobleskill scholarship will be reduced if a student receives a total in grants and scholarships that exceeds their total billed charges for the semester.
- 9. All Cobleskill scholarships require full time enrollment at SUNY Cobleskill and a minimum of 24 credits successfully completed each year (cross registration at other SUNY campuses does not count towards full time enrollment requirement for the purpose of scholarship awards).
- 10. The Presidential Scholarship, which covers housing and meals for up to 4 years, will be recalculated each year based on the current cost of a standard double occupancy room and an unlimited meal plan.
- 11. All scholarships will be cancelled (removed from the bill) if a student withdraws from the College.
- 12. On-campus residency is required for the Destination, Presidential, Honors, and Coby Wise scholarships and they will be cancelled if a student moves off campus before the end of the semester.
- 13. Some Cobleskill scholarships are supported by contributions from private donors. Students will



- be notified if their scholarship is funded in part by a private contribution. If this is the case, the student will be expected to write a thank you note to the individual donor and attend an annual scholarship luncheon.
- 14. All Cobleskill Scholarships (unless otherwise stipulated through a donor gift agreement) are designated to provide financial assistance toward non-tuition expenses and therefore will not reduce a NYS Excelsior scholarship.
- 15. The priority deadline to complete the Scholarship Questionnaire and FAFSA is May 1 each year. Meeting the priority deadline guarantees the availability of the scholarship funds. Submissions between May 2 and August 1 will be accepted but the scholarships will be then awarded on the first come first served basis.
 - Deadline for students starting in the Spring semester is December 1 each year.
- 16. To remain eligible, students must continue to meet the scholarship requirements (GPA, full-time status, campus housing residency, and submission of the annual questionnaire/FAFSA by the deadline). In cases where eligibility is affected by extenuating circumstances, students may request a review through the Financial Aid Office's appeal process.
