## **ARTICULATION AGREEMENT**

## between

## STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE AND TECHNOLOGY AT COBLESKILL and HIGH SCHOOL OF COMPUTERS AND TECHNOLOGY

## DECEMBER 2022 - DECEMBER 2027

The State University of New York College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill and the High School of Computers and Technology jointly endorse this articulation agreement impacting the graduates majoring in the Computer Maintenance Technology program at the High School of Computers and Technology. It is the intent of this agreement to recognize the breadth and depth of this program as a foundation for students who matriculate at SUNY Cobleskill as an Information Technology major within the School of Liberal Arts and Sciences. A candidate<sup>1</sup> from the High School of Computers and Technology who:

- 1. Receives a New York State high school diploma
- Follows the Computer Maintenance Technology curriculum and achieves an 85 or higher average in each course included in the curriculum and meets all other SUNY Cobleskill admission requirements for their major
- 3. Receives a written recommendation from the Computer Maintenance Technology instructor

will be offered by SUNY College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill;

- Guaranteed admission into an Information Technology major provided that the student meets admission requirements for the program and that there is availability within the program
- 2. The student must be enrolled for studies within a curricular area of Information Technology and be in good academic standing as defined by the college at the completion of the first semester of matriculation at SUNY Cobleskill
- 3. Will receive advanced standing credit for SUNY Cobleskill's courses:
  - CITA 120 Computer Hardware Concepts (3 semester credits)
  - -CITA 200 Introduction to Networking (2 semester credits)
  - -CITA 280 Computer Technology Internship (3 semester credits)

The student must complete and file a SUNY Cobleskill Admissions Application according to instructions. The letter of recommendation from the Computer Maintenance Technology instructor must accompany the application stating the student attends this institution, which has an articulation agreement with SUNY Cobleskill.

The effective date of this agreement is December 1, 2022 and will be reviewed for renewal, five years after signing, by the participating parties.
