ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

between

STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE AND TECHNOLOGY AT COBLESKILL

and

ERIE 1 BOCES

APRIL 2024 - APRIL 2029

The State University of New York College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill and the Erie 1 BOCES jointly endorse this articulation agreement impacting the graduates majoring in Animal Science from Erie 1 BOCES. It is the intent of this agreement to recognize the breadth and depth of the Animal Science curriculum at Erie 1 BOCES as a foundation for students who matriculate at SUNY Cobleskill in one of the majors within the Animal Science Department. A candidate from Erie 1 BOCES who:

- 1. Receives a New York State high school diploma
- 2. Follows the Animal Science curriculum and achieves an 85 average or higher in each course included in the above curriculum and meets all other SUNY Cobleskill admissions requirements for their major
- 3. Receives a written recommendation from an Erie 1 BOCES Animal Science instructor

will be offered by SUNY College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill, Department of Animal Science:

- 1. Guaranteed admission into either the Animal Industry AAS, Animal Science AAS, BT or BS or Canine Training and Management BT degree program, provided that the student meets admission requirements for the program and that there is availability within the program
- 2. Will receive 3 advanced standing credits for SUNY Cobleskill's course ANSC 140 Small Animal Management
- 3. Will receive 3 advanced standing credits for SUNY Cobleskill's course ANSC 101 Foundations in Animal Science

The student must complete and file a SUNY Cobleskill Admissions Application according to instructions. The letter of recommendation from the Erie 1 BOCES instructor must accompany the application stating the student attends this institution, which has an articulation agreement with SUNY Cobleskill.

In accordance with the provisions of the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act ("FERPA"), in order for SUNY Cobleskill to share information about the student from the student's educational records, Erie 1 BOCES must agree not to disclose the information to a third party without the student's consent, and to use the information only for the purposes for which it was disclosed. The laws of the State of New York shall govern this agreement without regard to conflict of law provisions. Any dispute arising under this Agreement shall be resolved in a court of competent jurisdiction in the State of New York. This Agreement contains the entire understanding of the parties with respect to the matters contained herein.

SUNY Cobleskill and Erie 1 BOCES agree to communicate any curriculum changes or policies, which affect the agreedupon relationship, as soon as it is reasonably possible. Both parties reserve the right to amend or

revise this agreement. These changes must be submitted in writing and signed by both parties.

The effective date of this agreement is April 1, 2024 and will be reviewed for renewal, five years after signing, by the participating parties.
