

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

between

STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK
COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE AND TECHNOLOGY AT COBLESKILL

and

ERIE 2-CHAUTAUQUA-CATTARAUGUS BOCES

MARCH 2021 – MARCH 2026

The State University of New York College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill and Erie 2-Chautauqua-Cattaraugus BOCES jointly endorse this articulation agreement impacting the graduates successfully completing the Power Equipment Technology program at Erie 2-Chautauqua-Cattaraugus BOCES. It is the intent of this agreement to recognize the breadth and depth of this program as a foundation for students who matriculate at SUNY Cobleskill in a major within the Agricultural Engineering Department. A candidate¹ from Erie 2-Chautauqua-Cattaraugus BOCES who:

1. Receives a New York State high school diploma
2. Follows the Erie 2-Chautauqua-Cattaraugus BOCES Power Equipment Technology curriculum, achieving an 85 or higher average in each course included in the above curriculum and meets all other SUNY Cobleskill admission requirements for their major
3. Receives a written recommendation from the Erie 2-Chautauqua-Cattaraugus BOCES Power Equipment Technology instructor

will be offered by SUNY College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill, Department of Agricultural Engineering:

1. Guaranteed admission into an Agricultural Engineering Department major, provided that the student meets admission requirements for the program and that there is availability within the program
2. Will receive 1-3 semester hours of advanced standing credit (after portfolio review) for SUNY Cobleskill's course AGEN 101 – Introduction to Agricultural Engineering.

The student must complete and file a SUNY Cobleskill Admissions Application according to instructions. The letter of recommendation from the Power Equipment Technology program instructor must accompany the application stating the student attends this institution, which has an articulation agreement with SUNY Cobleskill.

The effective date of this agreement is March 1, 2021 and will be reviewed for renewal, five years after signing, by the participating parties.




