

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

between

STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK
COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE AND TECHNOLOGY AT COBLESKILL
and

FONDA-FULTONVILLE HIGH SCHOOL

JUNE 2021 – JUNE 2026

The State University of New York College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill and Fonda-Fultonville High School jointly endorse this articulation agreement impacting the graduates successfully completing the CASE Introduction to Agriculture, Food, and Natural Resources program. It is the intent of this agreement to recognize the breadth and depth of this program as a foundation for students who matriculate in a Business, Food Service and Agricultural Management Department degree program. A candidate¹ from Fonda-Fultonville High School who:

1. Receives a New York State high school diploma
2. Follows the CASE Introduction to Agriculture, Food, and Natural Resources curriculum and achieves an 85 or higher average in each course included in the above curriculum and meets all other SUNY Cobleskill admission requirements for their major
3. Receives a written recommendation from the Fonda-Fultonville High School CASE Introduction to Agriculture, Food, and Natural Resources instructor

will be offered by SUNY College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill:

1. Guaranteed admission into a Business, Food Service and Agricultural Management Department degree program, provided that the student meets admission requirements for the program and that there is availability within the program
2. Will receive 3 semester hours of advanced standing credit for SUNY Cobleskill's course AGBU 101 - Introduction to Agricultural Business

The student must complete and file a SUNY Cobleskill Admissions Application according to instructions. The letter of recommendation from the CASE Introduction to Agriculture, Food, and Natural Resources instructor must accompany the application stating the student attends this institution, which has an articulation agreement with SUNY Cobleskill.


The effective date of this agreement is June 1, 2021, and will be reviewed for renewal, five years after signing, by the participating parties.






