# SEPTEMBER 2022 – SEPTEMBER 2027

The State University of New York College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill and Greater Southern Tier BOCES jointly endorse this articulation agreement impacting the graduates successfully completing the Welding program. It is the intent of this agreement to recognize the breadth and depth of this program as a foundation for students who matriculate at SUNY Cobleskill in a major within the Agricultural Engineering Department. A candidate<sup>1</sup> from Greater Southern Tier BOCES who:

- 1. Receives a New York State high school diploma
- 2. Follows the Welding program curriculum and achieves an 85 or higher average in each course included in the above curriculum and meets all other SUNY Cobleskill admission requirements for their major
- 3. Receives a written recommendation from the Greater Southern Tier BOCES Welding program instructor

will be offered by SUNY College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill, Department of Agricultural

- 1. Guaranteed admission into an Agricultural Engineering Department major, provided that the student meets admission requirements for the program and that there is availability within the program
- 2. 1-year students will receive advanced standing credit for SUNY Cobleskill's course AGEN 151 Basic Welding (2 semester credits)
- 3. 2-year students will receive advanced standing credit for SUNY Cobleskill's course AGEN 151 Basic Welding (2 semester credits) and will receive advance standing credit for SUNY Cobleskill's course AGEN 253 Advanced Welding (2 semester credits)

The student must complete and file a SUNY Cobleskill Admissions Application according to instructions. The letter of recommendation from the Welding program instructor must accompany the application stating the student attends this institution, which has an articulation agreement with SUNY Cobleskill.

The effective date of this agreement is September 1, 2022, and will be reviewed for renewal, five years after signing, by the participating parties.

Persons not meeting these criteria have the option of applying to SUNY Cobleskill under regular admission procedure. 1
