

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

between

STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE AND TECHNOLOGY AT COBLESKILL and

GALWAY CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT

JULY 2021 - JULY 2026

The State University of New York College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill and Galway Central School District jointly endorse this articulation agreement impacting the graduates successfully completing the CASE Principles of Agricultural Science program. It is the intent of this agreement to recognize the breadth and depth of this program as a foundation for students who matriculate at SUNY Cobleskill as a major within the Animal Science Department, Plant Science Department, or the Business, Food Service and Agricultural Management Department. A candidate¹ from Galway Central School District who:

- 1. Receives a New York State high school diploma
- 2. Follows the Galway Central School District CASE Principles of Agricultural Science curriculum and achieves an 85 average or higher in each course included in the above curriculum and meets all other SUNY Cobleskill admission requirements for their major
- 3. Has a written recommendation from the Galway Central School District CASE Principles of Agricultural Science program instructor

will be offered by SUNY College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill

- 1. Guaranteed admission into an Animal Science Department, Plant Science Department or Business, Food Service and Agricultural Management Department degree program, provided that the student meets admission requirements for the program and that there is availability within the program.
- 2. Will receive advanced standing credits for SUNY Cobleskill's course ANSC 199 Foundations of Animal Science (3 credits)
- 3. Will receive advanced standing credit for SUNY Cobleskill's course ORHT 105 Introduction to Horticulture (3 credits).
- 4. Will receive advanced standing credit for SUNY Cobleskill's course AGBU 101 Introduction to Agricultural Business (3 credits).

The student must complete and file a SUNY Cobleskill Admissions Application according to instructions. The letter of recommendation from the CASE Principles of Agricultural Science program instructor must accompany the application stating the student attends this institution, which has an articulation agreement with SUNY Cobleskill.

The effective date of this agreement is July 1, 2021 and will be reviewed for renewal, five years after signing, by the participating parties.

Persons not meeting these criteria have the option of applying to SUNY Cobleskill under regular admission procedure.
