

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

between

STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE AND TECHNOLOGY AT COBLESKILL and

GRANVILLE HIGH SCHOOL

SEPTEMBER 2022 – SEPTEMBER 2027

The State University of New York College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill and Granville High School jointly endorse this articulation agreement impacting the graduates successfully completing the Plant Science program. It is the intent of this agreement to recognize the breadth and depth of this program as a foundation for students who matriculate in a Plant Science Department degree program. A candidate from Granville High School who:

- 1. Receives a New York State high school diploma
- 2. Follows the Plant Science curriculum and achieves an 85 or higher average in each course included in the above curriculum and meets all other SUNY Cobleskill admission requirements for their major
- 3. Receives a written recommendation from the Granville High School Plant Science instructor

will be offered by SUNY College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill:

- 1. Guaranteed admission into a Plant Science Department degree program, provided that the student meets admission requirements for the program and that there is availability within the program
- 2. Will receive 3 semester hours of advanced standing credit for SUNY Cobleskill's course ORHT 105 Introduction to Horticulture

The student must complete and file a SUNY Cobleskill Admissions Application according to instructions. The letter of recommendation from the Plant Science instructor must accompany the application stating the student attends this institution, which has an articulation agreement with SUNY Cobleskill.

The effective date of this agreement is September 1, 2022, and will be reviewed for renewal, five years after signing, by the participating parties.

Persons not meeting these criteria have the option of applying to SUNY Cobleskill under regular admission procedure.
