

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

between

STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE AND TECHNOLOGY AT COBLESKILL and

GREENWICH CENTRAL SCHOOL

MAY 2022 - MAY 2027

The State University of New York College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill and Greenwich Central School jointly endorse this articulation agreement impacting the graduates successfully completing the Plant Science program. It is the intent of this agreement to recognize the breadth and depth of this program as a foundation for students who matriculate at SUNY Cobleskill in a major within the Plant Sciences Department. A candidate¹ from Greenwich Central School who:

- 1. Receives a New York State high school diploma
- 2. Follows the Greenwich Central School Plant Science curriculum and achieves an 85 average or higher in each course included in the above curriculum and meets all other SUNY Cobleskill admission requirements for their major
- 3. Has a written recommendation from the Greenwich Central School Plant Science instructor

will be offered by SUNY College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill, Department of Plant Sciences:

- 1. Guaranteed admission into a Plant Sciences Department major, provided that the student meets admission requirements for the program and that there is availability within the program
- 2. Will receive advanced standing for SUNY Cobleskill's course ORHT 105 Introduction to Horticulture, 3 semester credits

The student must complete and file a SUNY Cobleskill Admissions Application according to instructions. The letter of recommendation from the Greenwich Central School Plant Science program instructor must accompany the application stating the student attends this institution, which has an articulation agreement with SUNY Cobleskill.

The effective date of this agreement is May 1, 2022, and will be reviewed for renewal, five years after signing, by the participating parties.

Persons not meeting these criteria have the option of applying to SUNY Cobleskill under regular admission procedure.
