

## ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

between

STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK  
COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE AND TECHNOLOGY AT COBLESKILL  
and

HAMILTON-FULTON-MONTGOMERY BOCES

OCTOBER 2021 – OCTOBER 2026

The State University of New York College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill and Hamilton-Fulton-Montgomery BOCES jointly endorse this articulation agreement impacting the graduates successfully completing the Culinary Arts program. It is the intent of this agreement to recognize the breadth and depth of this program as a foundation for students who matriculate at SUNY Cobleskill as a Culinary Arts major within the Department of Business, Food Service and Agricultural Management. A candidate<sup>1</sup> from Hamilton-Fulton-Montgomery BOCES who:

1. Receives a New York State high school diploma
2. Follows the Hamilton-Fulton-Montgomery Culinary Arts curriculum, achieving an 85 or higher average in each course included in the above curriculum and meets all other SUNY Cobleskill admission requirements for their major
3. Receives a written recommendation from the Hamilton-Fulton-Montgomery Culinary Arts instructor

will be offered by SUNY College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill, Department of Business, Food Service and Agricultural Management:

1. Guaranteed admission into a Culinary Arts program, provided that the student meets admission requirements for the program and that there is availability within the program
2. Will receive advanced standing credit for SUNY Cobleskill's course CAHT 111 Culinary Arts 1 (3 credits)
3. Will receive advanced standing credit for SUNY Cobleskill's course CAHT 103 Food Service Sanitation (2 credits), if the student has a valid ServeSafe Food Protection Manager's Certification
4. Will receive advanced standing credit for SUNY Cobleskill's course CAHT 140 Mathematics Hospitality Operations (3 credits) after student earns a 75% on the Math Challenge exam given the first week of classes at SUNY Cobleskill

The student must complete and file a SUNY Cobleskill Admissions Application according to instructions. The letter of recommendation from the Culinary Arts program instructor must accompany the application stating the student attends this institution, which has an articulation agreement with SUNY Cobleskill.

The effective date of this agreement is October 1, 2021, and will be reviewed for renewal, five years after signing, by the participating parties.

<sup>1</sup> Persons not meeting these criteria have the option of applying to SUNY Cobleskill under regular admissions procedures.


