

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

between

STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE AND TECHNOLOGY AT COBLESKILL

and

CATTARAUGUS-ALLEGANY BOCES

JULY 2020 - JULY 2025

The State University of New York College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill and the Cattaraugus-Allegany BOCES jointly endorse this articulation agreement impacting the graduates successfully completing the Heavy Equipment Operations program at Cattaraugus-Allegany BOCES. It is the intent of this agreement to recognize the breadth and depth of this program as a foundation for students who matriculate at SUNY Cobleskill in a major within the Agricultural Engineering Department. A candidate¹ from Cattaraugus-Allegany BOCES who:

- 1. Receives a New York State high school diploma
- 2. Follows the Cattaraugus-Allegany BOCES Heavy Equipment Operations curriculum, achieving an 85 or higher average in each course included in the above curriculum and meets all other SUNY Cobleskill admission requirements for their major
- 3. Receives a written recommendation from the Cattaraugus-Allegany BOCES Heavy Equipment Operations instructor

will be offered by SUNY College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill, Department of Agricultural Engineering:

- 1. Guaranteed admission into an Agricultural Engineering Department major, provided that the student meets admission requirements for the program and that there is availability within the program
- 2. Will receive 1-3 semester hours of advanced standing credit (after portfolio review) for SUNY Cobleskill's course AGEN 101 Introduction to Agricultural Engineering.

The student must complete and file a SUNY Cobleskill Admissions Application according to instructions. The letter of recommendation from the Heavy Equipment Operations program instructor must accompany the application stating the student attends this institution, which has an articulation agreement with SUNY Cobleskill.

The effective date of this agreement is July 1, 2020 and will be reviewed for renewal, five years after signing, by the participating parties.

Persons not meeting these criteria have the option of applying to SUNY Cobleskill under regular admission procedure.
