

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

between

STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE AND TECHNOLOGY AT COBLESKILL and DUTCHESS BOCES CAREER AND TECHNICAL INSTITUTE

JANUARY 2020 – JANUARY 2025

The State University of New York College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill and the Dutchess BOCES Career and Technical Institute jointly endorse this articulation agreement impacting the graduates successfully completing the Culinary Arts program at the Dutchess BOCES Career and Technical Institute. It is the intent of this agreement to recognize the breadth and depth of this program as a foundation for students who matriculate at SUNY Cobleskill as a Culinary Arts major within the Agricultural Business & Culinary Arts Department. A candidate from Dutchess BOCES Career and Technical Institute who:

- 1. Receives a New York State high school diploma
- 2. Follows the Dutchess BOCES Career and Technical Institute Culinary Arts curriculum and achieves an 85 average or higher in each course included in the above curriculum and meets all other SUNY Cobleskill admission requirements for their major
- 3. Receives a written recommendation from the Dutchess BOCES Career and Technical Institute Culinary Arts instructor

will be offered by SUNY College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill, Agricultural Business & Culinary Arts Department:

- 1. Guaranteed admission into a Culinary Arts program, provided that the student meets admission requirements for the program and that there is availability within the program
- 2. Will receive advanced standing credit for SUNY Cobleskill's course CAHT 111 Culinary 1 (3 semester credits) and will also receive advanced standing credits for SUNY Cobleskill's course CAHT 103 Food Service Sanitation (2 semester credits), if the student has a valid Serv Safe Certificate
- 3. Will receive advanced standing credit for SUNY Cobleskill's course CAHT 140 Mathematics Hospitality Operations (3 semester credits) after the student earns a 75% on the Math Challenge exam given the first week of classes at SUNY Cobleskill

The student must complete and file a SUNY Cobleskill Admissions Application according to instructions. The letter of recommendation from the Culinary Arts instructor must accompany the application stating the student attends this institution, which has an articulation agreement with SUNY Cobleskill.

The effective date of this agreement is January 1, 2020 and will be reviewed for renewal, five years after signing, by the participating parties.

Persons not meeting these criteria have the option of applying to SUNY Cobleskill under regular admission procedure.
