

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

Between
STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK
COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE AND TECHNOLOGY AT COBLESKILL

and

EASTERN LONG ISLAND ACADEMY OF APPLIED TECHNOLOGY

JUNE 2020 - JUNE 2025

The State University of New York College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill and Eastern Long Island Academy of Applied Technology hereby establish an articulation agreement for students participating in the Computer Technology & Repair program. It is the intent of this agreement to recognize the breadth and depth of this program as a foundation for students who matriculate at SUNY Cobleskill in a major within the Business & Information Technology Department. A candidate¹ from Eastern Long Island Academy of Applied Technology who:

1. Receives a New York State high school diploma;
2. Follows the Computer Technology & Repair curriculum, achieves an 85 or higher average in each course included in the curriculum, and meets all other SUNY Cobleskill admission requirements for their major;
3. Receives a written recommendation from the Computer Technology & Repair instructor

will be offered by SUNY College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill, School of Business & Liberal Arts and Sciences:

1. Guaranteed admission into an Information Technology major, provided that the student meets admission requirements for the program and that there is availability within the program.
2. The student must be enrolled for studies within a curricular area of Information Technology and be in good academic standing as defined by the college at the completion of the first semester of matriculation at SUNY Cobleskill.
3. Will receive advanced standing credit for SUNY Cobleskill's following courses:
 - CITA 115- Introduction to Operating Systems (3 credits)
 - CITA 200- Introduction to Networking (3 credits)
 - CITA 230- Computer Networks (3 credits)

The student must complete and file a SUNY Cobleskill Admissions Application according to instructions. The letter of recommendation from the Computer Technology & Repair instructor must accompany the application stating the student attends this institution, which has an articulation agreement with SUNY Cobleskill.

The effective date of this agreement is June 1, 2020 and will be reviewed for renewal, five years after signing, by the participating parties.

¹ Persons not meeting these criteria have the option of applying to SUNY Cobleskill under regular admission procedure.


