

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT between

STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE AND TECHNOLOGY AT COBLESKILL and

EASTERN LONG ISLAND ACADEMY OF APPLIED TECHNOLOGY

JUNE 2020 – JUNE 2025

The State University of New York College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill and Eastern Long Island Academy of Applied Technology jointly endorse this articulation agreement impacting the graduates successfully completing the Welding/Metal Fabrication program. It is the intent of this agreement to recognize the breadth and depth of this program as a foundation for students who matriculate at SUNY Cobleskill in a major within the Agricultural Engineering Department. A candidate from Eastern Long Island Academy of Applied Technology who:

- 1. Receives a New York State high school diploma
- 2. Follows the Welding/Metal Fabrication curriculum and achieves an 85 average or higher in each course included in the above curriculum and meets all other SUNY Cobleskill admission requirements for their major
- 3. Receives a written recommendation from the Welding/Metal Fabrication instructor

will be offered by SUNY College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill, Department of Agricultural Engineering:

- 1. Guaranteed admission into an Agricultural Engineering Department major, provided that the student meets admission requirements for the program and that there is availability within the program
- 2. 1-year students will receive 1-3 semester hours of advanced standing credit (after portfolio review) for SUNY Cobleskill's course AGEN101 Introduction to Agricultural Engineering
- 3. 2-year students will receive 1-3 semester hours of advanced standing credit (after portfolio review) for SUNY Cobleskill's course AGEN101 Introduction to Agricultural Engineering AND 2 semester hours of advanced standing credit for SUNY Cobleskill's course AGEN151 Basic Welding

The student must complete and file a SUNY Cobleskill Admissions Application according to instructions. The letter of recommendation from the Welding/Metal Fabrication program instructor must accompany the application stating the student attends this institution, which has an articulation agreement with SUNY Cobleskill.

The effective date of this agreement is June 2020 and will be reviewed for renewal, five years after signing, by the participating parties.

Persons not meeting these criteria have the option of applying to SUNY Cobleskill under regular admission procedure.
