

## ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

## between

## STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE AND TECHNOLOGY AT COBLESKILL

and

## HOMER CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL

JUNE 2021 – JUNE 2026

The State University of New York College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill and Homer Central High School jointly endorse this articulation agreement impacting graduates successfully completing the CASE Principals of Agriculture, Food, and Natural Resources Program. It is the intent of this agreement to recognize the breadth and depth of this program as a foundation for students who matriculate at SUNY Cobleskill in a major within the School of Agriculture and Natural Resources. A candidate<sup>1</sup> from Homer Central High School who:

- 1. Receives a New York State high school diploma
- 2. Follows the Principals of Agriculture, Food, and Natural Resources curriculum, achieving an 85 average or higher in each course included in the above curriculum and meets all other SUNY Cobleskill admission requirements for their major
- 3. Has a written recommendation from the instructor

will be offered by SUNY College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill, Department of Agricultural Business & Culinary Arts within the School of Agriculture and Natural Resources:

- 1. Guaranteed admission into the Agricultural Business AAS or the Agricultural Business Management BS or BT degree program, provided that the student meets admission requirements for the program and that there is availability within the program
- 2. Will receive 3 semester hours of advanced standing credit for SUNY Cobleskill's course AGSC 131 Introduction to Sustainable Agriculture
- 3. Will receive 3 semester hours of advanced standing credit for SUNY Cobleskill's course AGBU 101 Introduction to Agricultural Business

The student must complete and file a SUNY Cobleskill Admissions Application according to instructions. The letter of recommendation from the instructor must accompany the application stating the student attends this institution, which has an articulation agreement with SUNY Cobleskill.

The effective date of this agreement is June 1, 2021 and will be reviewed for renewal, five years after signing, by the participating parties.

Persons not meeting these criteria have the option of applying to SUNY Cobleskill under regular admission procedure.
