

Transfer Articulation Agreement
between
STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK
COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE AND TECHNOLOGY AT COBLESKILL
and
FULTON-MONTGOMERY COMMUNITY COLLEGE

November 2012

This agreement establishes procedures to promote the easy transition of associate degree graduates from Fulton-Montgomery Community College (FMCC) to the Business Administration B.B.A. degree program at the State University of New York College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill (SUNY Cobleskill).

Objectives of the Agreement

1. To promote the easy transition of qualified students from FMCC to these upper-degree programs at SUNY Cobleskill.
2. To provide a transfer path and specific information to transfer students who wish to pursue baccalaureate degrees.
3. To attract qualified students to FMCC and SUNY Cobleskill.
4. To exchange information on success and failures of the transfer program in order to improve it.

Terms of the Agreement

1. Students from FMCC, who have completed an associate degree in Business and the courses outlined in the addendums, with a minimum 2.25 cumulative grade point average will be guaranteed admission into the BBA Business Administration program at SUNY Cobleskill with full junior status.
2. Transfer students must complete and file the SUNY Admissions Application indicating transfer to SUNY Cobleskill prior to November 1 for spring semester entry, and prior to March 1 for fall semester entry.
3. Courses transferring in as required or elective courses, bearing the major field prefixes, must have grades of C or better to be accepted for transfer credit.
4. Students who do not meet the requirements of this agreement will also be considered for admission. They will be evaluated on an individual basis.

Review and Revision of the Agreement

This joint agreement will be reviewed when substantial changes are made in the curriculum on either campus. At the request of either party, a review of the Transfer Articulation Agreement will be conducted by both institutions.


Termination

This agreement will become effective November 2012, upon acceptance of Agreement with appropriate signatures.


