

Student Housing Room Types & Designations

Alumni Commons Suite Single (ACSU) —A single-occupancy bedroom within a three- or four-person unit at Alumni Commons.

Alumni Commons Townhome Single (ACTH) —A single-occupancy bedroom within a six-person townhome at Alumni Commons.

Deluxe Double (DDBL) —A triple-occupancy bedroom within any residence hall which traditionally had been shared by three students but has now been designated for only two students to select to occupy for the upcoming academic year.

Deluxe Single (DSNG) —A double-occupancy bedroom within any residence hall which traditionally has been shared by two students but has now been designated for only one student to select to occupy for the upcoming academic year; the room will include two single beds which the occupant can use for themselves or a guest in accordance with our guest regulations.

Medical Single / Deluxe Single Medical Reserve (DSMR) — A bedroom within any residence hall which has been designated or converted to function as a single to be occupied only by a student with a medical accommodation, when authorized as eligible by the Committee on Special Housing Accommodations. In cases where a medical reserve room was previously suitable for double-occupancy, the room may include two single beds which the occupant can use for themselves or a guest in accordance with our guest regulations. The cost for this room type will not exceed the cost of a standard double for the current semester of occupancy.

Standard Double (DBL) —A double-occupancy bedroom within any residence hall which has two beds and is intended to be occupied by two students.

Standard Single (SNGL) —A single-occupancy bedroom within any First-Year residence which that has one bed and may only be occupied by one student.

Super Single (SSNG) —A double-occupancy bedroom within any residence hall which was intended to be shared by two students but becomes available at any time after fall classes commence to purchase for single occupancy for the remainder of the current semester. Super Singles will not be sold in advance of the academic year but may be offered after fall classes begin depending on space availability and housing demand. Rooms sold as super singles will continue to include two single beds which the assigned occupant can use for themselves or a guest in accordance with our guest regulations. The cost for this room type will be equal to the cost of a deluxe single for the current semester of occupancy.

Triple Occupancy (TRPL) —Although SUNY Cobleskill no longer offers nor regularly assigns three to students to share a bedroom, triple occupancy accommodations may be necessary on a temporary basis if there is a spike in bed demand and/or maintenance needs arise which warrant closure of a section of a building or a building(s). In the case this occurs, students who are assigned or reassigned to share a bedroom with two other people will be assessed the discounted triple-occupancy room rate on a prorate basis.

Vroman Suite Double (SDBL) —A double-occupancy bedroom within a shared Vroman Hall Suite which has two beds and is intended to be occupied by two students.

All Gender Housing – "All Gender" generally refers to buildings and communities – like Alumni Commons – where students can select bedrooms to live in regardless of their gender identity. *Please note, at this time, bedrooms are not assigned to students of different sexes. But students of any sex or gender identity may select or be assigned to live right next to each other in many residence halls or they may share suites or apartments together in Vroman Hall or Alumni Commons.*

Mixed Gender Housing – "Mixed Gender" broadly refers to areas within residences where there are a mix of male- and female-designated bedrooms, suites or apartments available.
