STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

Every SUNY Cobleskill LPP activity is designed to develop students' personal and academic knowledge and build skills to assist in their progress toward success in high school and in their future education and careers. By signing this Student Code of Conduct, you accept the provisions herein with the understanding that they are meant to identify your responsibilities during LPP-sponsored events, trips, and activities, including classroom tutorial sessions.

- 1) I will dress appropriately, maintaining my school's dress code, including, but not limited to: no offensive t-shirts, no hats in buildings, and no underwear showing.

- 2) I will behave so I do not distract from my own or others' benefit, including, but not limited to: no offensive or inappropriate language, no overt displays of affection, and no physical or verbal harassment of any kind upon any person or persons, whether student or adult.

- 3) I will not discriminate or harass any student or employee, either with or without physical contact and/or by verbal threats, intimidation or abuse, of such a severe nature that it...
 ...has or would have the effect of unreasonably and substantially interfering with a student's educational performance, opportunities or benefits, or mental, emotional and/or physical well-being; or
 ...reasonably causes or would reasonably be expected to cause a student to fear for his or her physical safety.

Such conduct shall include, but is not limited to, threats, intimidation, or abuse based on a person's actual or perceived race, color, weight, national origin, ethnic group, religion, religious practices, disability, sexual orientation, gender as defined in Education Law §11(6), or sex.

- 4) I will strive to attend school every day, because I know that if I am not in school, I cannot learn and I will be at risk of getting behind in my work, which will negatively affect my academic progress.

- 5) I understand that my teachers expect me to complete assignments, even if I miss class for an LPP activity. If I choose not to make an effort in my classes or I choose not to make up missed assignments, my teacher is justified in requiring my presence in class instead of allowing me to go on the next LPP trip. Likewise, my LPP tutor/mentor is justified in denying my participation in LPP activities for the same reason.

- 6) I understand that if I conduct myself in such a way as to be in opposition to the responsibilities identified above, my LPP tutor/mentor or LPP director may curtail and/or prohibit my participation in any or all LPP activities.
