GUIDELINES FOR FIELD TRIPS



- ❖ There will be **NO** smoking by students or chaperones while on the buses, waiting for trips to start, during trip activities (including lunch) or while waiting for departure. Smoking materials will be considered contraband and will be confiscated.

- ❖ Student behavior should reflect the setting involved. In all cases, the setting will be structured.
 - Students will obey all directions (instructions) of trip chaperones as well as the person presenting information.
 - Students should be encouraged to participate where appropriate. If they choose not to, they should remain quiet and attentive so as not to deny other students the opportunity for positive participation.
 - There will be no vulgar, loud, or threatening language toward anyone.
 - All people will avoid physical or verbal harassment of their schoolmates, other schools' students, or the people presenting information on the trips.
 - Students should remain in constant visual contact with their school's Coordinator or the Liberty Coordinator.
 - Students should dress appropriately for the site of the field trip, as well as the weather. Clothes should be clean, neat, and non-offensive. Hats are not to be worn inside buildings.
 - Electronic devices, such as cell phones, Ipods, ear phones, etc. are not to be used during presentations, but may be used on the bus.

- ❖ All additional rules of individual schools will be followed by students from those schools.

Please remember you are not only representing yourselves and your school, but also the Liberty Partnerships Program. We do not want to jeopardize our return, in future years, to these places due to the misbehavior of our students.

Any infractions to these rules will be addressed by LPP and your school. Consequences could range from a mere acknowledgement of our disappointment in the student's behavior to exclusion from one or more trips to expulsion from the program, based upon the severity of the infraction.
